









IIJA Funding Breakdown







Tax Incentives, J Corporate 55%






IIJA Funding By State












Grant Tips and Tricks

Grant Positioning Tips

- Start with planning and community engagement / needs
- Look for funding to complete a project, don't create a project to fit funding
- Coordinate across departments internally and regionally
- Prioritize your community's capital needs and develop a project pipeline

- Become familiar with state agencies and work with them to make sure your community or region's needs are appropriately mapped and inventoried
- Establish relationships with the federal agency regional offices
- Engage your congressional delegation
