NMPP's Mutual Aid Program provides disaster recovery assistance 24 hours/day, 365 days/year by coordinating emergency assistance for participating communities.

When a tornado or blizzard strikes, communities and their utilities aren't alone in their time of need. This program has proven to be a valuable service and one that many of the program's participants and consumers are thankful to have available.



Coordination assistance through mobile app and website

NMPP staff coordinates utility crews, trucks and equipment necessary to repair or replace electric systems damaged by storms. Mutual aid support requests can be made through a mobile app for Android and Apple phones (search for "NMPP Operations" in your phone's app store) as well as a website for desktop use. Program requirements

NMPP Energy's Mutual Aid program was developed with the League of Nebraska Municipalities years ago with the vision of assisting member communities of both groups. An agreement was worked out that protects all entities participating in any type of mutual assistance, including liability and recovery of associated costs. NMPP Energy and the League have made this program available to all of their respective members at no cost. The only requirements to participate are:

- Utilities sign the program agreement
- Provide proof of equipment and employee insurance
- Complete a data request survey
