All qualifying scholarships under MEAN's Scholarship Program must be related to the electric utility industry. Scholarship funds must be used within one year from the award date. If the award funds are not used within one year, the funds must be returned to MEAN.

The Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska's scholarship program provides funding assistance for educational opportunities for municipal employees of MEAN long-term power participants




MEAN APPA National Conference Scholarship

This scholarship is available for municipal employees and elected officials from MEAN long-term power participant communities under the Service Schedule M (SSM) contract. The scholarship provides funding assistance for MEAN board members to attend the American Public Power Association's National Conference.

Funding parameters

• The APPA National Conference Scholarship provides funding for up to 100 percent of the registration/tuition fee. It does not cover expenses such as travel, meals and lodging.



Scholarship funding parameter

Each long-term MEAN power participant community is eligible for \$2,500 per fiscal year. These funds may be split among the programs however the community chooses.

MEAN Lineworker Scholarship

This scholarship is available to MEAN participant communities that purchase bulk power under the Service Schedule M or K (SSM/SSK) power schedules. It provides funding assistance to any program, workshop, conference, etc. related to lineworker-specific areas.

Funding parameters

The MEAN Lineworker Scholarship provides funding for up to 100 percent of the registration/tuition fee. It does not cover expenses such as travel, meals and lodging.



MEAN General Scholarship

This scholarship is available for municipal employees and elected officials from MEAN participant communities that purchase bulk power under the Service Schedule M or K (SSM/SSK) power schedules. The scholarship provides funding assistance for:

- Utility and lineworker training
- Economic and community development
- Safety training
- · Training for elected officials and clerks
- · APPA-sponsored courses

Funding parameters

 The General Scholarship provides for up to 100 percent of the registration/tuition fee. It does not cover expenses such as travel, meals and lodging.
